6. Scenario: Third grader falls from some climbing bars and is unable to get up. Child is complaining of leg pain. Please describe what you would do in the order of execution.
7. Scenario: A teacher has just reported to you that a first grader has head lice. Share with us your first five steps?

8. How would you rate your computer skills on scale of 1 – 5? Five being proficient in the use of Excel, Word, Power Point. Give examples.
  
9. Give three characteristics of an extremely organized nurse. How would you rate yourself in those areas? (1 – 5)
  
10. What are some things you would take into consideration if a staff member asked you for medical advice?
  
11. Name three specific skills you have that are a perfect match for this position.
  
12. Are you hearing and/or vision screening certified? If not, it is an expectation of the job. How would you go about obtaining the appropriate certifications?
  
13. Are you CPR/AED certified?
  
14. Are you available to work as a sub on non-assigned days?
